Session description:

The current global process of transforming the energy sector from fossil fuels to zero carbon or based on energy from renewable sources implies several challenges for future energy generation, distribution and storage systems. As representative examples of these systems we can mention smart grids, renewable energy or fuel generation and storage systems, energy management systems in buildings, propulsion systems for non-polluting vehicles for aerial, maritime or land transportation, among other systems. This special session addresses the problem of efficient energy management in such a type of systems and the goal is to present some recent advancements in the application of control, monitoring and/or intelligent decision-making solutions.

The topics of interest include, but are not limited to:

- Model-based control approach including cyber-physical systems approach
- System of systems control solutions
- Condition-based monitoring
- Al-based solutions for control and/or monitoring
- Fusion of control strategies
